We, the undersigned family, freely enter into this agreement. As parents, we ask the parish to help us provide our child(ren) with a Catholic Education. We understand and agree that our child(ren) will be taught the teachings of the Catholic Church in their fullness. We are committed to working with the parish and school to forge a Catholic culture of respect for all students and families. We will therefore cooperate with and actively support those who provide a Catholic education for our children- the priests, parishioners, and all school personnel and their policies. We embrace our duty to ensure that our actions and those of our children are consistently focused on treating all others with fairness, dignity, and kindness as having been made in the image and likeness of God.

We understand that *practicing parishioner* defines as a household in which:

- The Catholic faith is shared by making discipleship a priority and a way of life;
- Any children are baptized or in the process of preparing for baptism;
- Gratitude is shown for God's gifts by spending time with God in prayer, service of others, and generosity to those less fortunate than us.
- Family members participate in parish ministries, each according to his or her time and talents as part of a stewardship way of life;
- Members attend Mass every Sunday and for Holy Days of Obligation.

- I/We commit to adhering to the policies in the School Handbook, including:
 - Paying tuition and all other necessary fees on time;
 - Working to develop positive communication with the principal and teachers;
 - Encouraging good study habits and making homework a priority;
 - Volunteering for various school functions when needed;
- I/We commit to practicing the faith at home, including:
 - Praying as a family at meals and spending time together as a family on a regular basis, especially on Sundays;
 - Promoting solid moral teaching in the use of television, technology, and video games;
